

ATV/UTV riding popularity has risen in the past several years. The Town of Prairie du Sac opened select roads for street legal ATV/UTVs. The Town has a good working relationship with the Honey Creek ATV/UTV club. They are managing the signs on the Town roads. The club strives to make ATV/UTV riding a safe and enjoyable experience. A few key points regarding ATV/UTV riding in the Town of Prairie du Sac:

Only certain Town of Prairie du Sac roads are designated routes for street legal ATV/UTVs. These roads are signed with route signs.



The end of a route is also signed.

It is not legal to ride ATV/UTVs on State Highways or on any road or street that does not have ATV Route signage including Town Roads, County Roads, as well as Village, Town and City roads. Be sure to check with each governing municipality before heading out for a ride.

Riding on private property without the permission of the landowner is not legal.

In the Town of Prairie du Sac, the riding hours on signed routes are 1/2hr before Sunrise to 1/2hr after Sunset. The speed limit is set at 35MPH unless posted otherwise.


Operations of ATVs and UTVs on designated ATV/UTV routes are subject to all provisions of s.23.33 Wisconsin State Statutes.
